The Classis Ministry Committee (CMC) consists of the Administrative Committee and the representatives of the ministries/committees within Classis: Safe Church Team, Atie Ott; Waterloo Campus Ministry, Carolyn Kleefman; Treasurer, Evert Nagel (ex officio); Mission Team, Jane Vander Velden; Mission Catalyzer, Joan Brady; Diaconal Ministries & World Renew, Mary Blydorp; Guelph Campus Ministry, Melissa Burmaster (interim); Ministerial Leadership Team, Wesley Collins; Prayer Catalizer, Rev. Sid Couperus, Youth Champion, (currently vacant).

The <u>duties</u> include: Nurturing vision and planning within Classis, Providing accountability, guidance, and support for existing ministries of Classis, Provide governance support for Classis Huron.

Administrative Committee (AdCom) consists of Albert Hovingh (Chair), Rev. Victor Laarman (vice), and Rev. Amanda Bakale (at-large/interim). Fred Vander Sterre (Stated Clerk, ex officio).

AdCom takes care of all matters between Classis meetings and is empowered to act in an administrative capacity, and is accountable to CMC.

The **Stated Clerk** serves Classis Huron by keeping accurate records of the proceedings, decisions, and rules of Classis as per Church Order, Article 32-b. The Rules of Classis Huron also task the Clerk to serve as a resource to the churches of Classis on matters of order and procedure, maintain the records and website of Classis, and serve as a central point of communication for Classis, among other responsibilities.
