Mandate: Classis Huron Safe Church Committee is mandated:

- 1. To function as an Abuse Response Team according to Synodical Guidelines (as annotated for Classis Huron).
- 2. To provide comprehensive and on-going education and support to our churches in the prevention of and response to abuse.
- 3. To provide support to our churches in the prevention of, and response to abuse.

Membership Update:

We are still in need of representatives of the Acton, Cambridge and Orangeville churches. Representatives have a key role in contributing to the ongoing issues and events, ensuring that all churches in Classis Huron have a voice and are kept informed.

Annual Inter-Classis Safe Church Conference

On March 5th Classis Huron Safe Church Committee hosted their Annual Safe Church Conference. The virtual conference consisted of two webinars. The first was a virtual tour of the former Mohawk Institute Indian Residential School, presented by the Woodland Cultural Centre (Brantford ON). The second a presentation by Priya Andrade (interim Canadian Justice and Reconciliation Mobilizer Indigenous Ministry, CRCNA), which focused on CRC's engagement in the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's calls to action in Canada by repenting and lamenting its role in the cultural in the cultural violence committed towards Indigenous Peoples. The webinars proved to be very popular and filled up quickly resulting in a wait list which we were able to eliminate by encouraging small groups of people to join the webinar together.

Abuse Awareness Sunday


