16. CMC/AdCom/Stated Clerk Report

16.1 CMC Report

The Classis Ministry Committee consists of representatives of all ministries/committees within Classis: Chair, Rev. Stephen Tamming; Vice-chair, Rev. Vicki Verhulst Cok, Member at Large: Rev. Martin Dam: Classis Ministry Leadership Team, Rev. Brian Bork; Home Missions Committee, Rev. Henry Steenbergen; Safe Church Committee, Atie Ott; Huron Campus Ministry (Guelph), Rev. David Tigchelaar; Diaconal Ministries, Mary Blydorp: Huron Campus Ministry (Waterloo), Rev. John Medendorp; Youth Ministry, Amy Baarda; Treasurer John Bell, ex-officio, and Stated Clerk, Rev. Vic Vandermolen, ex officio.

CMC continues to support and encourage the various committees and ministries that are part of Classis, and shares the following information:

- 1. Andrew Nunn has resigned his position as Commissioned Pastor at Bethel CRC, Acton. By becoming part of the polity and practice of Forward Baptist Church in Cambridge, and the denomination it is part of, his status as Commissioned Pastor in Bethel CRC has come to an end.
- 2. CMC is reviewing the current procedure for obtaining a license to exhort. It is intended that the current format for examination re practica and theology will remain in place, but ask candidates to preach a sermon in a regular church service setting and having that service critiqued by appointed evaluators. This would be similar to the process for those seeking ordination. Changes to current rules of procedure in this area are also being considered. Classis will be asked for its approval once the review is concluded.
- 3. In response to an issue raised at the February 2017 Classis meeting, a short survey was recently sent to all churches re holding Classis meetings on a Saturday. Classis will be advised of results of this survey at the May 24 meeting.
- 4. CMC is reviewing the Classis Huron web site, and considering how best to update and reformat its current structure. Classis will be kept informed of progress and decisions.
- 5. Clarence Louter, a longtime member of the Finance Resources Team has resigned this position [Thank you Clarence!]. A new member for the Committee is being sought.
- 6. Ralph Bakker of Palmerston has resigned his position as Auditor for Classis. Jacinda Reitsma of Waterloo has agreed to take on that position.

In addition to these clerical issues, CMC submits the following recommendations for Classis' approval:

A. Seeking to make the selection of delegates to Synod a more streamlined process, and easier to

administer, CMC recommends that Classis replace the process it approved at the February 2016 meeting by the following:

- i] That Classis Huron annually send two Minister delegates and one Elder Delegate and one Deacon Delegate to Synod as its delegates.
- ii] That the two ministers receiving the most votes be declared Synod Delegates, with the minister receiving the highest number of votes being designated as the 'Minister Delegate' and the Minister receiving the second highest number of votes being designated as the 'Fourth Delegate'.
- iii] That the Minister receiving the third highest number of votes be designated as the 'Alternate Minister Delegate' and the Minister receiving the fourth highest number of votes be designated as the 'Alternate Fourth Delegate'
- iii] That the Elder delegate and his/her alternate be selected by vote from a list of approved elder nominees presented to Classis for delegation to synod, with the 'alternate elder delegate' being the person receiving the second highest number of votes.
- iv] That the Deacon delegate and his/her alternate be selected by vote from a list of approved deacon nominees presented to Classis Huron for delegation to synod, with the 'alternate deacon delegate' being the person receiving the second highest number of votes.
- B] That in light of the number of persons already licensed to exhort within Classis Huron, Classis not accept any further requests for licensure to preach until May 2018.

16.2 Administrative Committee (AdCom)

The Administrative Committee of Classis (AdCom) works on behalf of classis between meetings. AdCom consists of Rev. Stephen Tamming, [chair], Rev. Vicki Verhulst Cok [vice-chair], Rev. Martin Dam, [Member] and Stated Clerk Rev. Vic Vandermolen, ex-officio. Since the last meeting of classis, AdCom has met to respond to issues raised at the last meeting of Classis, and also to address a number of new matters, which have subsequently been referred to CMC and are addressed above.

16.3 Stated Clerk

The Stated Clerk serves as secretary of Classis Huron, its Classis Ministry Committee [CMC], and Administrative Committee (AdCom). The Clerk continues to respond to ongoing requests for information and direction from individual members, church leadership, classis committees, and denominational offices. Since February 2017 to the time of writing this report, the Clerk has:

- dealt with/responded to some 73 telephone conversations and requests for information.
- dealt with/responded to some 610 email messages and requests for information from Denominational agencies, Classis Huron churches, Classis Huron members, and more.
- participated in a video conference call with Canadian Ministries Director Rev. Darren Roorda, and other Canadian Stated Clerks.
- attended, prepared agendas for, wrote minutes for, and did follow-up work and correspondence for two AdCom meetings, one CMC meeting, and one Classis meeting: this is in addition to meetings and conversations with CRCNA/pastors/members and others re various issues dealing with matters relative to Classis and its member churches.
- prepared a summary of the February 2017 Classis meeting, and forwarded same to all Classis Huron churches.
- on behalf of Denominational agencies, para-church organizations, and others, forwarded numerous announcements and other information, to Classis Huron churches, on a regular basis.
- filed minutes and agendas of Classis meetings with both CRCNA Canada and the Denominational offices, and forwarded these to Classis Huron churches also.
- with the assistance of the Alternate Stated Clerk continued to develop the agenda, determine and contact speakers, and attendant information, for the Classis Huron Administrators' Day scheduled for November 1, 2017 at Bethel CRC in Listowel
- responded to numerous written and verbal request for opportunities to address Classis at this meeting, and upcoming meetings.
- prepared the agenda and attachments for Classis May 24, 2017
