

 Disaster Alert · Myanmar Earthquakes: On March 28, devastating earthquakes with magnitudes of 7.7 and 6.4 struck Myanmar, claiming the lives of over 3,000 people, destroying homes and infrastructure, and displacing countless families. The situation has become more dire by the recent onset of heavy rains.

World Renew is responding alongside our partners and network peers in Asia to share Christ's hope and provide urgent relief. Your gift will help deliver food, shelter, medical support, clean water, and other essentials to the most vulnerable.

Please consider holding a special offering in your church to support this response. We also ask for your prayers for ongoing peace and restoration

A mother of six in Kenya, she has flourished through the Maternal & Child Health program in her community.
