Greetings from Redeemer University

It was a privilege to welcome members of your Classis to Synod 2025 this past May at Redeemer University. With so much support from so many Christian Reformed Churches, it was a blessing to share warm hospitality in return. The Reformed Christian worldview remains at the heart of the student experience, and your prayers and financial gifts make this possible.

Enrolment Continuing to Grow

Redeemer is entering a milestone year of student growth, program development and God's unwavering faithfulness. As of the writing of this report, estimates indicate that this will be another record-breaking year for both overall enrolment and new students in residence with a little over 1,100 total students and nearly 600 in residence.

Impacting More Educators

This spring, Redeemer's School of Education graduated 58 educators, its largest cohort in history. To accommodate this growth, for the first time ever, Redeemer hosted a separate ceremony for Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) students. The B.Ed. program remains highly competitive and produces well qualified teachers for both public and private schools.

Church Student Placements

This past academic year, Redeemer helped coordinate 30 co-op placements and 132 internship placements, maintaining partnerships with 152 workplaces. Redeemer would love to partner with you in creating a student internship or co-op opportunity at your church. Nineteen majors have the option of a co-op and/or internship, including programs like mission and ministry, youth ministry, urban ministry, media production, business - marketing, and social work. Redeemer is entering its next phase of new program development, offering a not-for-profit management certificate and preparing to launch both a master of education in 2026 and a master of arts in counselling in 2027.
